It also aims to contribute to closing the gap in life expectancy by improving access to culturally appropriate mainstream primary care services (including but not limited to general practice, allied health and specialists) for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. The ITC program provides funding for Care Coordinator and Outreach Worker positions across the NT, as well as Indigenous Health Project Officers to support the ITC workforce. Care Coordinators Outreach Workers work with clients with complex needs as part of the Closing the Gap strategy through the Australian Government Indigenous Australian Health Program.
